
Spaza® Dispenser **Bracket System**

This instruction is designed for use with all products that are delivered with pre-applied tape, including lockable and non-lockable brackets in single, double, and triple versions.

C. SCREW METHOD

PRE-INSTALLATION PREPARATIONS A, B, C

Because Spaza cannot anticipate all the different possible surfaces or possible contaminants that may exist in the contact surface, it is imperative that the user conduct an evaluation to determine the suitability of surface preparations procedures, and any other processes that may have an influence on the bonded parts.

Before installing our products, we recommend conducting a test installation in a designated room to assess functionality and compatibility.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION, TAPE METHOD A

Surface Preparations - The wall surface must be flat, clean, and dry. In case of a surface promotor needed consult a local supplier or distributor to determine which of the available primers and surface promotors are most suitable in your region.


Contact - Bond strength is dependent upon the amount of adhesive-tosurface contact developed. Firm application pressure in 60 seconds develops better adhesive contact and helps improve bond strength. The bracket should experience at least 1 kg/cm² in pressure.

Wait - After application, the bond strength will increase as the adhesive flows onto the surface. At room temperature, approximately 90% will be achieved after 24 hours and 100% after 72 hours. Using primer will shorten these time intervals.

A. TAPE METHOD

1. Measure 120 cm (48") from floor to top of holder, and mark position of contact surface with pencil or piece of masking tape.*







B. GLUE METHOD

1. Measure 48 inches (120 cm) from floor to top of bracket, and mark position of each drill hole with pencil.*



2. Clean contact surface with isopropanol alcohol (IPA), let dry thoroughly prior to installation. Applying a primer will improve initial and ultimate adhesion to many materials.



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2. Drill holes, drill depth minimum 40 mm. Insert wall anchors into hole by carefully tapping with hammer.



3. Peel of backing of adhesive strip on bracket, do not touch any of the adhesive tape or wall surface.



3. Install cover plugs in the bracket screwholes. Apply the glue to the back side of bracket.



3. Clean contact surface with isopropanol alcohol (IPA), let dry thoroughly prior to installation.



4. Aim the holder to the wall in level. Press entire holder firmly against the wall for 60 seconds to ensure holder has adhered to surface.



4. Aim the bracket to the wall in level and press to ensure glue has spread over the contact surface
